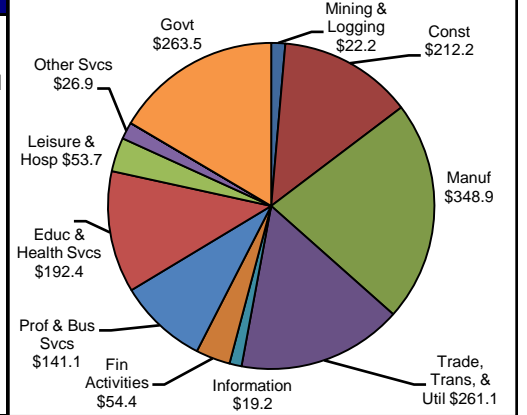

Comments for January 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Beaumont-Port Arthur MSA lost -2,200 jobs in January. Since January 2009, the MSA lost -9,600 positions or -5.9 percent. The employment loss was primarily caused by Retail Trade and Mining, Logging, and Construction, with declines of -800 and -300, respectively. The decline in Retail trade was mainly due to stores reducing staff following the holiday season. While Education and Health Services and Government both had losses of -200 each, both had positive annual growth rates. Education and Health Services gained 400 jobs since January 2009, with an annual growth rate of 1.8 percent. Government had an annual growth rate of 1.5 percent. Manufacturing, Wholesale Trade, Transportation, Warehousing and Utilities, and Professional and Business Services had over-the-month decreases of -100 positions each.
