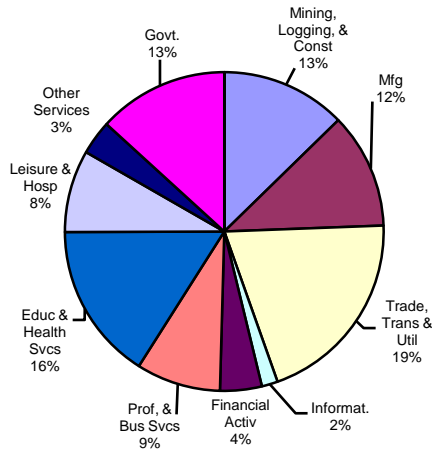
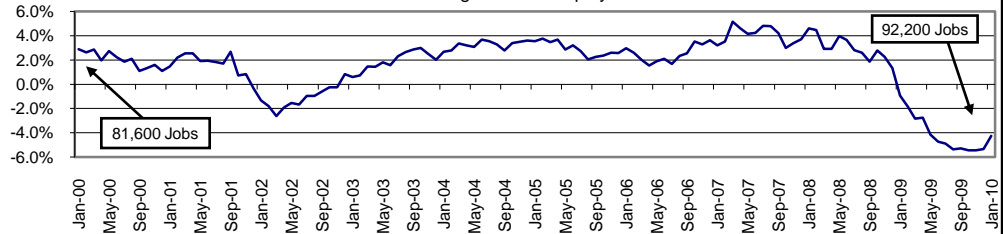


### Industry Composition



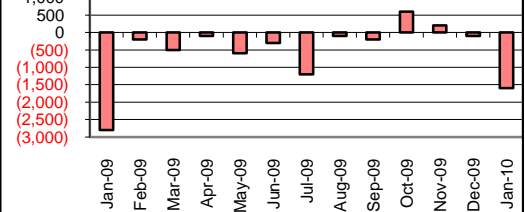
### Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

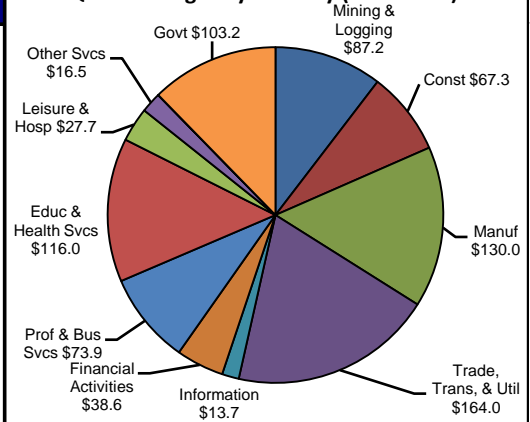

## Comments for January 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Longview MSA declined by -1,600 jobs in January. Trade, Transportation, and Utilities accounted for the largest declines, shedding -700 positions as the holiday shopping season ended. Local Government declined by -400 jobs, accounting for a quarter of the monthly losses. Mining, Logging, and Construction, Professional and Business Services, and Education and Health Services all experienced modest declines. Leisure and Hospitality shed -200 jobs and was the only other industry to decline. All other industries remained steady for the month. Education and Health Services, Leisure and Hospitality, and Government were the only industries to experience over-the-year job growth. The January data brings the Longview MSA to an annual growth rate of -4.3 percent, losing -4,100 jobs over the past year.
