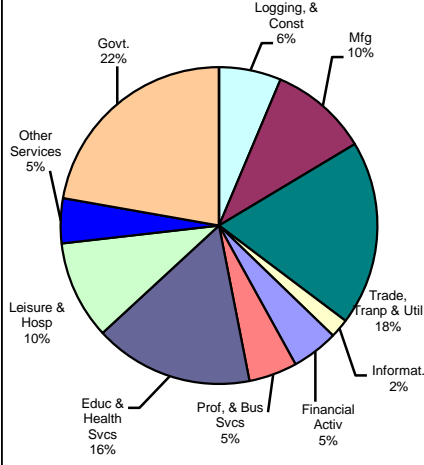
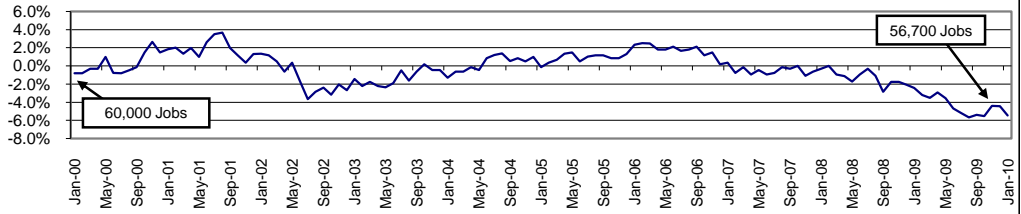


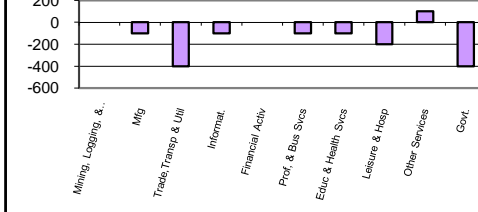
Industry Composition



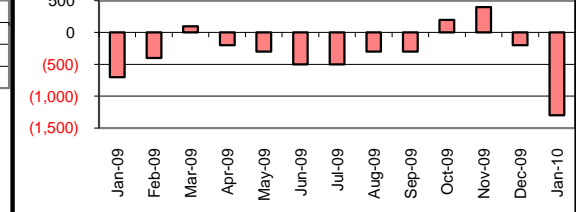
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

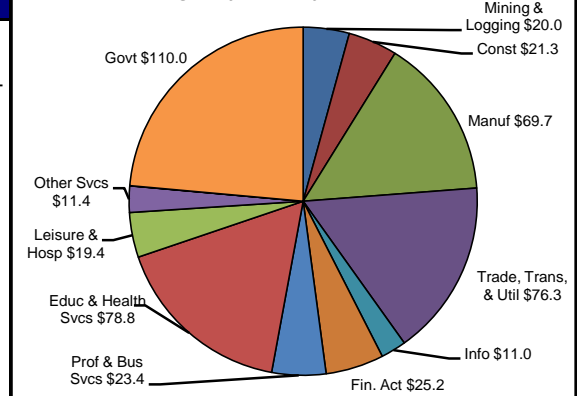

Comments for January 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Wichita Falls MSA declined by -1,300 jobs in January. Trade, Transportation, and Utilities declined by -400 positions as the holiday shopping season came to a close. State Government declined by -400 positions, and Leisure and Hospitality contracted by -200 jobs. Manufacturing, Information, Professional and Business Services, and Education and Health Services all experienced moderate decreases in employment. Other Services added 100 jobs and was the only industry to exhibit monthly growth. Education and Health Services and Other Services are the only industries to exhibit annual growth. Since January 2009, the Wichita Falls MSA has lost -3,300 jobs, representing an annual growth rate of -5.5 percent.
